Conditions and Responsibilities relating to Application for Membership

The following NOTES should be understood by Proposers, Seconders and APPLICANTS before the application form is signed and returned to the office.

1. Applicants for membership should where possible be proposed and seconded by playing members who hold a share in Dartford Golf Club Limited.
2. The Proposer and Seconder must have known the applicant for at least TWO years.
3. The application must be accompanied by letters of recommendation from both Proposer and Seconder, who expected to encourage their nominee to integrate and support club activities. They will be especially responsible for the Applicant's general behavior and conduct both on the course and in the clubhouse.
4. The Proposer and Seconder must each have played with the Applicant on at least THREE occasions at Dartford Golf Club and scorecards, showing some indication of the candidate's golfing ability, should be submitted with the application form.
5. The Applicant must have been encouraged by Proposer and Seconder to attend the Club socially (organised function, restaurant dining, etc.) and whenever possible to have been introduced to members of the Board and the Club Secretary.
6. The Proposer and Seconder are allowed to nominate two applicants only in any two-year period. They are also asked to attend at their nominee's interview.
7. **In circumstances where candidates do not know any Full Members to propose and second them, they may submit two letters of recommendation incorporating a character reference. It is not necessary then to complete part B of the form.**

Please ensure you have completed the following before submitting your application:

- 1) Your Proposer & Seconder have signed the form (if applicable).**
- 2) You have attached their supporting letters or two character references.**
- 3) You have attached a passport-style photograph to the application form.**

DARTFORD GOLF CLUB DRESS CODE

GENERAL

Members and guests are expected to be reasonably attired at all times - it is the personal responsibility of Members to ensure that they and their guests comply with the DGC dress code or the standards defined by The Ladies' Committee.

'Jacket and Tie' is mandatory for Club Matches and specified events.

Smart Clean Golf Wear is the minimum requirement in all areas of the clubhouse except:

- in the Stud Bar/Games Room
- in the Restaurant after 6 pm and at Sunday Lunch.

In the Stud Bar/Games Room only, Golf Wear which has been worn on the course (including golf shoes) is permitted.

In the Restaurant after 6 pm and at Sunday Lunch, Smart Casual Wear is the minimum requirement.

Shirts must be properly tucked in at all times.

Socks should be worn at all times and, if worn with shorts, should be predominantly white and clearly visible above the shoe.

ACCEPTABLE DRESS

Tailored jacket with shirt and tie/cravat/roll neck sweater for gentlemen is welcomed at any time.

Smart Casual Wear is defined as trousers (not shorts) with smart, tailored and buttoned shirt with a collar (not a golf shirt) or roll neck sweater.

Acceptable Golf Wear is defined as that normally available in the professional's shop, including golf shoes.

UNACCEPTABLE DRESS

Denim.

Trousers tucked into socks.

Incorrectly worn headgear, i.e. peaks must be worn to the front.

Hats, or bare or stockinged feet in the Clubhouse.

Shoes or sandals worn without socks.

The wearing of golf shoes and water/windproofs in the Lounge and Restaurant.

The wearing of shorts in the Lounge and Restaurant after 6 PM.

Zipped, plastic or sweater-type jackets are not included within the definitions of 'Jacket and Tie' nor 'Smart Casual'.

NOTES

In the Stud Bar and Games Room it is expected that excessively wet or soiled golf clothing/shoes be avoided, in order to keep these areas clean and tidy.

Permitted exceptions to this dress code will be allowed from time to time, e.g. Firework Night. Such occasions will be specifically designated by the Board and appropriate notices clearly displayed beforehand.
