

## DARTFORD GOLF CLUB

### Conditions and Responsibilities relating to Application for Membership

*The following NOTES should be understood by Proposers, Seconders and APPLICANTS before the application form is signed and returned to the office.*

1. Applicants for membership should where possible be proposed and seconded by playing members who hold a share in Dartford Golf Club Limited.
2. The Proposer and Secunder must have known the applicant for at least TWO years.
3. The application must be accompanied by letters of recommendation from both Proposer and Secunder, who expected to encourage their nominee to integrate and support club activities. They will be especially responsible for the Applicant's general behavior and conduct both on the course and in the clubhouse.
4. The Proposer and Secunder must each have played with the Applicant on at least THREE occasions at Dartford Golf Club and scorecards, showing some indication of the candidate's golfing ability, should be submitted with the application form.
5. The Applicant must have been encouraged by Proposer and Secunder to attend the Club socially (organised function, restaurant dining, etc.) and whenever possible to have been introduced to members of the Board and the Club Secretary.
6. The Proposer and Secunder are allowed to nominate two applicants only in any two-year period. They are also asked to attend at their nominee's interview.
7. **In circumstances where candidates do not know any Full Members to propose and second them, they may submit two letters of recommendation incorporating a character reference. It is not necessary then to complete part B of the form.**

**Please ensure you have completed the following before submitting your application:**

- 1) Your Proposer & Secunder have signed the form (if applicable).**
- 2) You have attached their supporting letters or two character references.**
- 3) You have attached a passport-style photograph to the application form.**

### IN THE STUD BAR - SMART GOLF WEAR - NO HEADGEAR

### IN THE CLUBHOUSE

	<b>YES In Lounge and Restaurant</b>	<b>NO</b>
<b><u>General</u></b>	Smart clean golf wear throughout. In the Bar & Restaurant after 6 pm (7pm BST*) smart casual wear ( <i>see definition below #</i> ).	Water/windproofs, wet or soiled clothing, golf shoes or hats in the Bar or Restaurant
<b><u>Shirts</u></b>	Shirts must have collars and be tucked into trousers at all times.	Shirts displaying names or numbers other than golf logos.
<b><u>Jackets &amp; Ties</u></b>	On Sundays tailored jackets with shirt & tie/cravat/roll neck sweater must be worn in the Lounge/Restaurant from 12 noon until 6pm. Jackets are not required during BST*.	Zipped, plastic or sweater-type jackets with stiff collared shirts.
<b><u>Footwear</u></b>	No spikes in the Lounge or Restaurant.	Bare or stockinged feet. Shoes or sandals worn without socks. <b>NO TRAINER SOCKS WITH SHORTS FOR MEN.</b>
<b><u>Shorts</u></b>	Tailored shorts (not more than 4" above the knee) permitted everywhere but not in the Lounge and Restaurant after 6pm (7pm BST*).

# **SMART CASUAL DEFINITION:**

**TROUSERS WITH SMART, TAILORED & BUTTONED SHIRT WITH A COLLAR (*not a golf shirt*)**

### ON THE COURSE

<b><u>Trousers/ Shorts</u></b>	Tailored full length or 3/4 length trousers or shorts (maximum 4 inches above the knee).	
<b><u>Shirts</u></b>	Shirts must have collars or be turtle neck golf shirts. To be tucked into trousers at all times.	Shirts displaying large names or numbers. Football shirts.
<b><u>Footwear</u></b>	Golf shoes only (with knee length or ABOVE ANKLE WHITE SPORTS SOCKS for men wearing shorts).	Trainers. <b>NO TRAINER SOCKS FOR MEN.</b>
<b><u>Headgear</u></b>	All headgear must be worn correctly.	'Back-to-front' headgear.

### LADIES

The Ladies' Committee is responsible for the standard of dress of their Section and is to ensure that all Ladies conform to the spirit of the gentlemen's dress regulations.
